Read carefully! There will be a blood moon eclipse in the early morning hours of Wednesday. After FPCC Print Night on Tuesday, we will drive to Goldendale. Goldendale Observatory will open from midnight to 7 am for eclipse viewing. Observatory website here:

Check-In: 4 pm\*; Check-Out: 11 am

Amenities: 100% smoke-free, free parking, free shuttle around town (available from 7:30 am to 9:30 pm), free Wi-Fi and free breakfast.

You must call their toll-free number at: 800/752-5752 to book your room. Be sure to mention that you are with FILM PACK CAMERA CLUB.

Manager has offered a rate of \$130\* plus tax for a King or One-Queen Suites. If you're interested in sharing a room, a Double Queen Suite is available for \$153. This would have a queen bed in the bedroom and a queen bed in the living area. Pet suites are available, too!

Take notice: A deposit for the first night & tax is required. Your deposit is refundable if you cancel by 4 pm seven days prior to arrival.

The same management company runs Friday Harbor House. They would not budge on their room rates which start at \$169 and up-even in mid-October.
